 - Placemaking/Activation chaired by Stefan van Niekerk, CoJ Development Planning



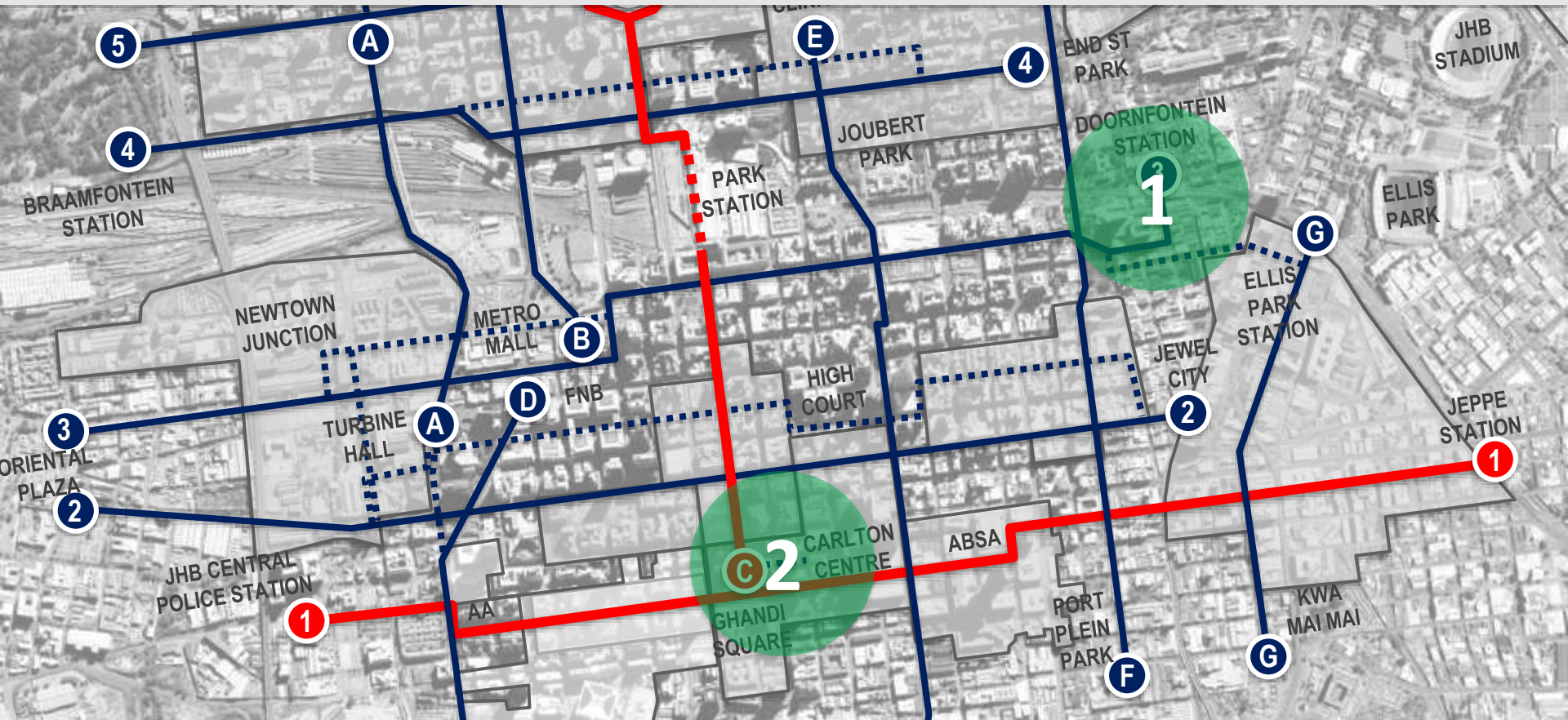
Walkable Network Route Reconfiguration

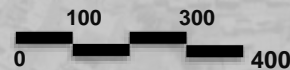

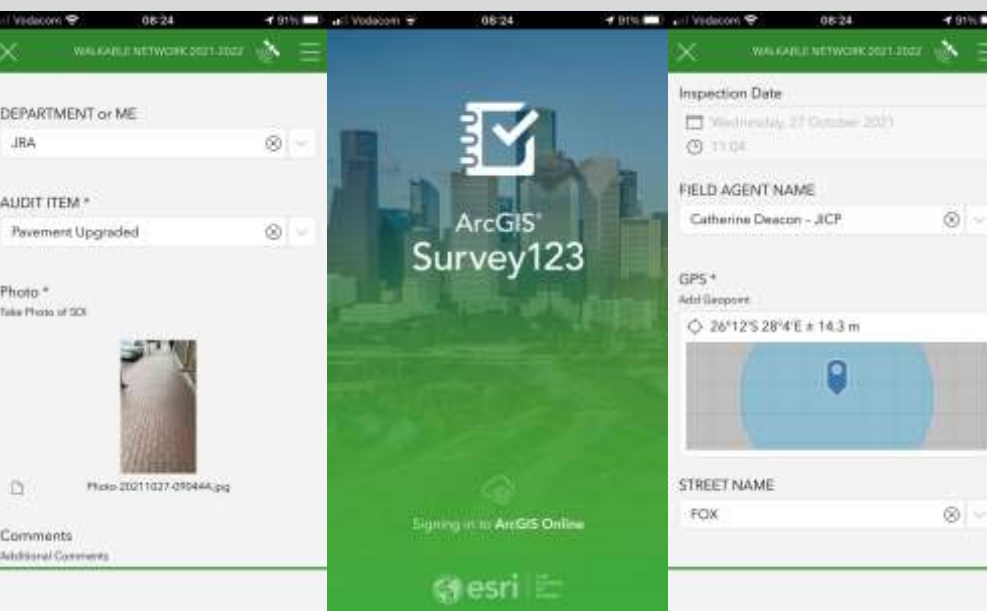

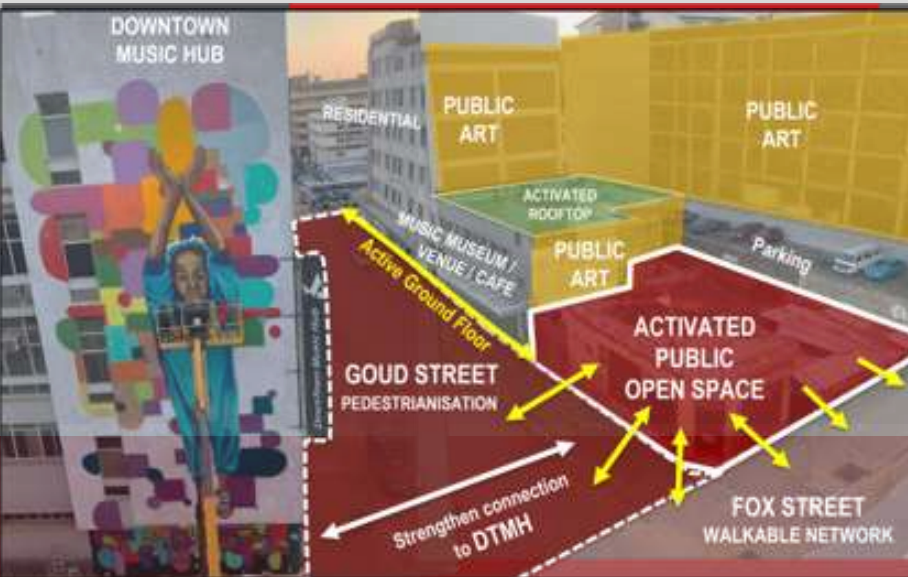

Walkable Network Capex

- Additional capex request via Development Planning's Inner City Partnership Fund submitted - awaiting outcome of budget process
- UN Habitat grant submitted for tactical urbanism activation along WN Pilot (Fox Street)
- CoJ Development Planning Hello Joubert tactical urbanism undertaken in 2021

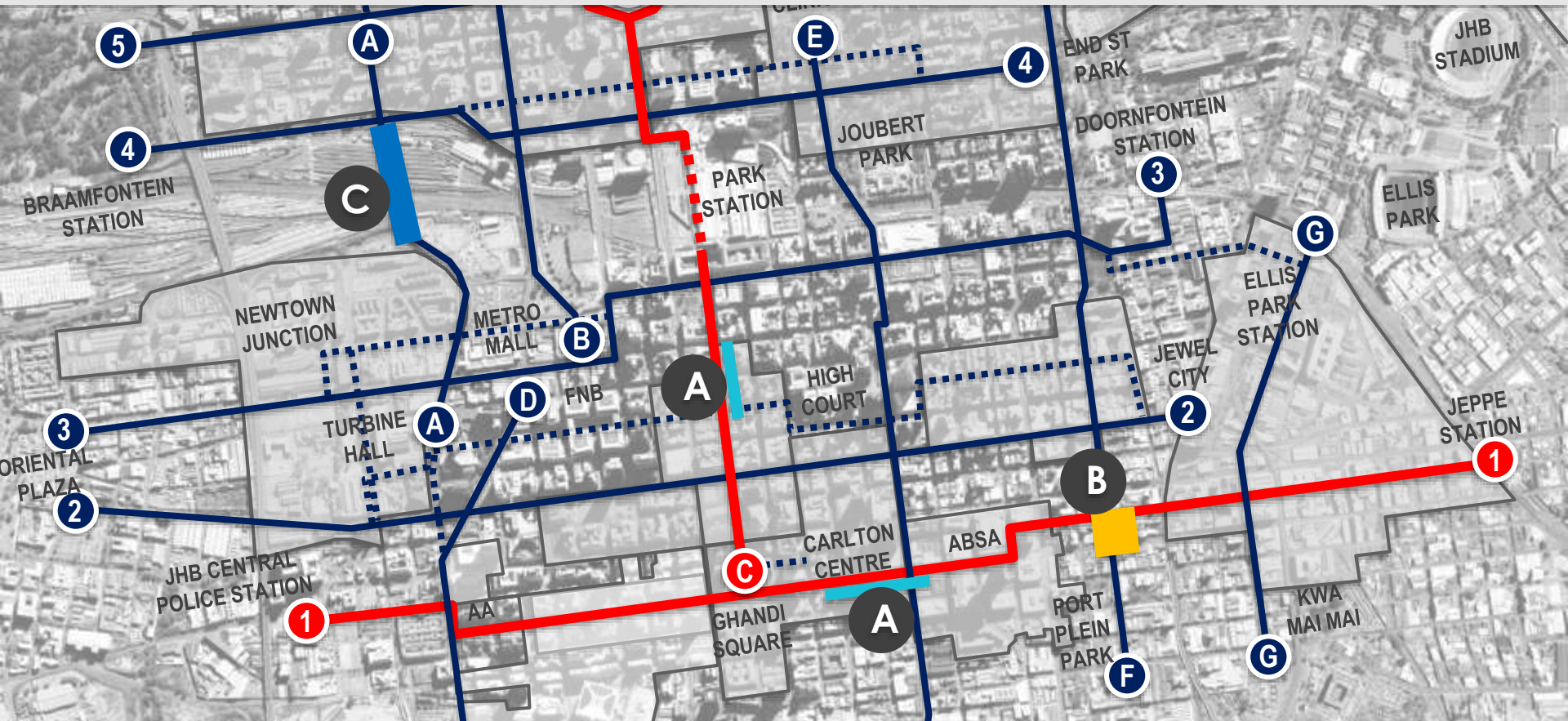


Walkable Network Funding Submission to CoJ

#	Capex Item	Description
A	Walkable Network Upgrades	Full public environment upgrade of degraded street blocks and other associated public realm components.
B	DTMH Public Space	Acquisition and upgrade of a site at the corner of Goud and Fox Streets, opposite the Downtown Music Hub including an amphitheatre, support facilities and ablutions. Street closure of Goud Street between Fox and Main Streets.
C	Nelson Mandela Bridge	Inspection recently undertaken by JRA. Replacement/repairs to walkway handrails, gap sealing plates, glass panels, concrete parapet walls and bollards, crash barrier and lighting.
D	CCTV	Nature of funding (Capex/Opex) TBD

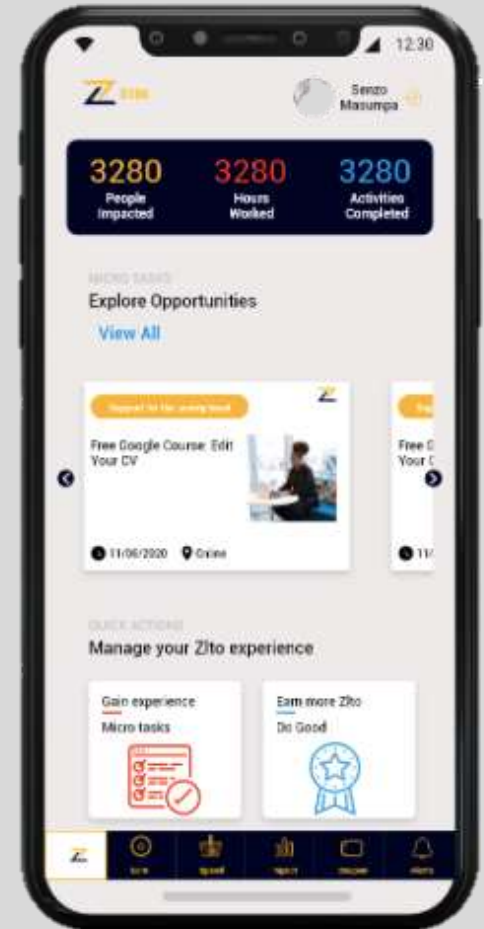
